

The new game sheets will print 4 to a page. This was done so they will fit in the referee books that you use on the field. There is a lot of important information contained on these sheets, so ensure they are completely filled out. Home team and Away team are split up to different sides of the game sheet to help you separate the information.

Date, Time, Field, Division and Ref Name
 This space is to put the date and time of the game, the field and division and your name. Check weather you were the referee or a linesperson

Colour & Number

This is for the jersey colour and team number for both the Home and Away teams

Y?R – This is for you to note whether you gave a Red or Yellow card
- This is the player jersey number
Time – this is the time the card was given (e.g. 35 would be the 35th minute which would be in the 1st half and 85 would be 85th minute which would be in the 2nd half)

- This is the player jersey number
Goals – This is the number of goals scored by each player (hash marks would probably be the best way to use this section)

Final Score

This is where you count up the goals and write in the final score for the game
